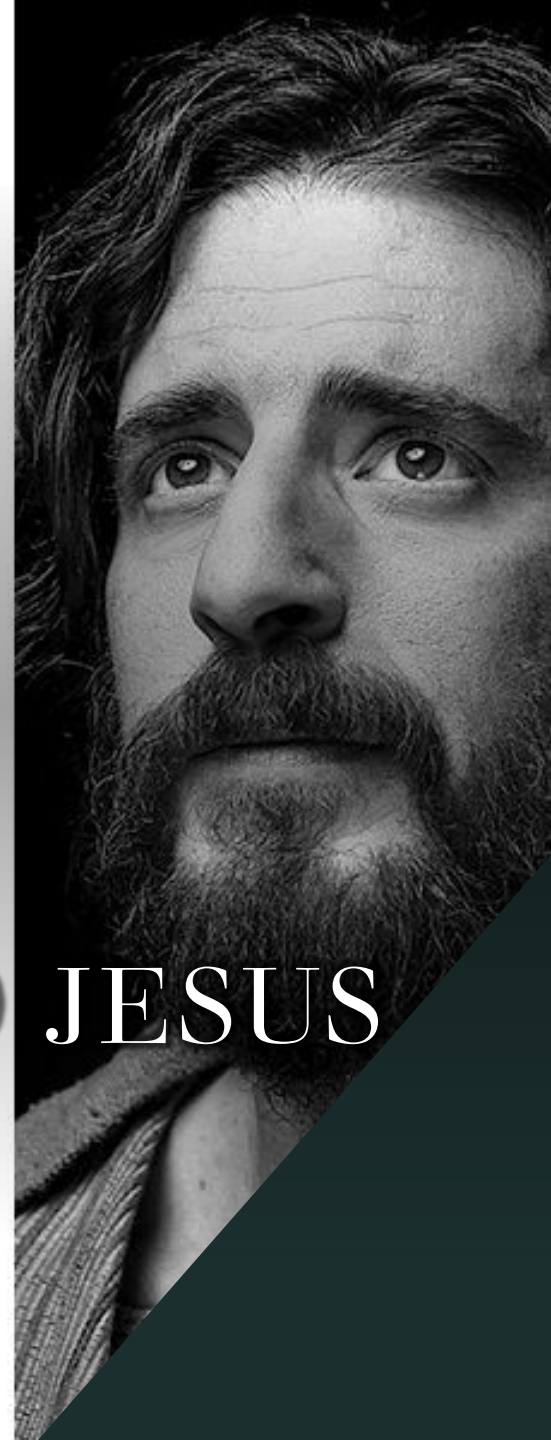
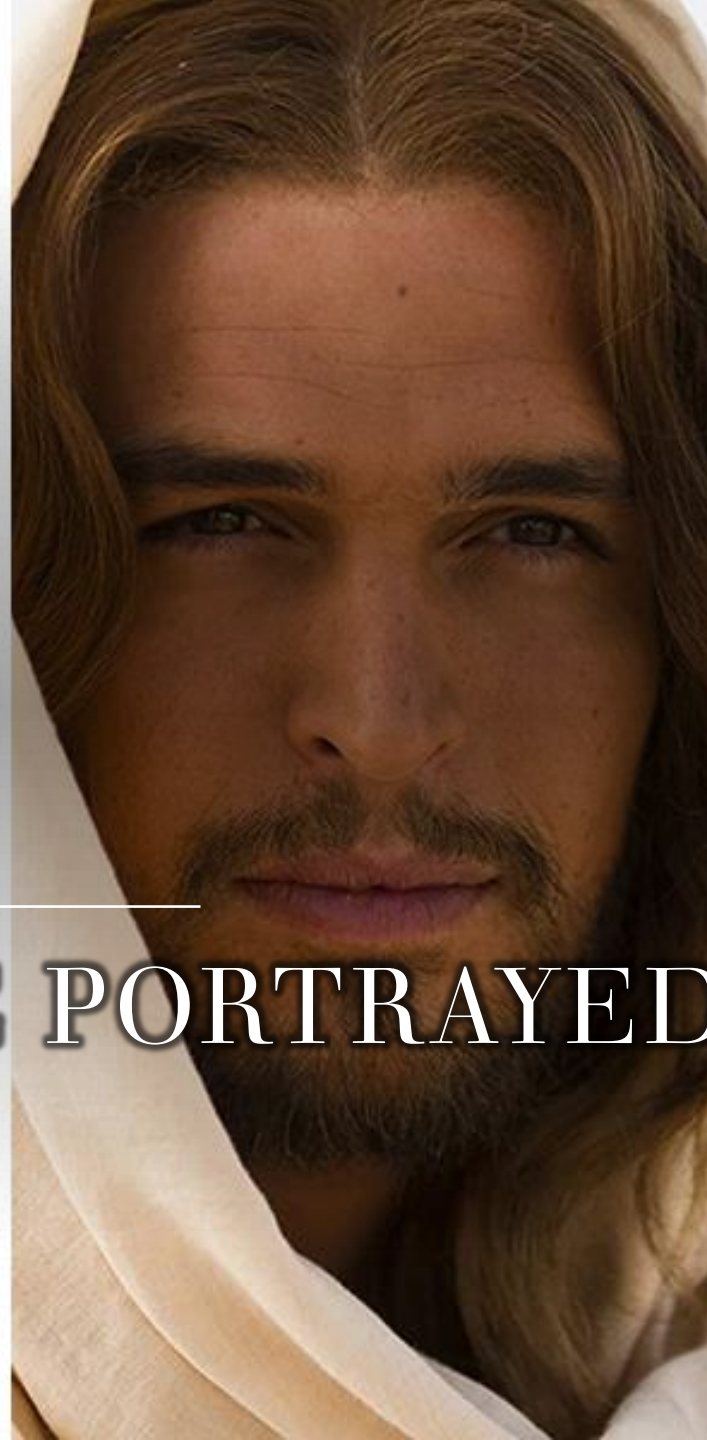
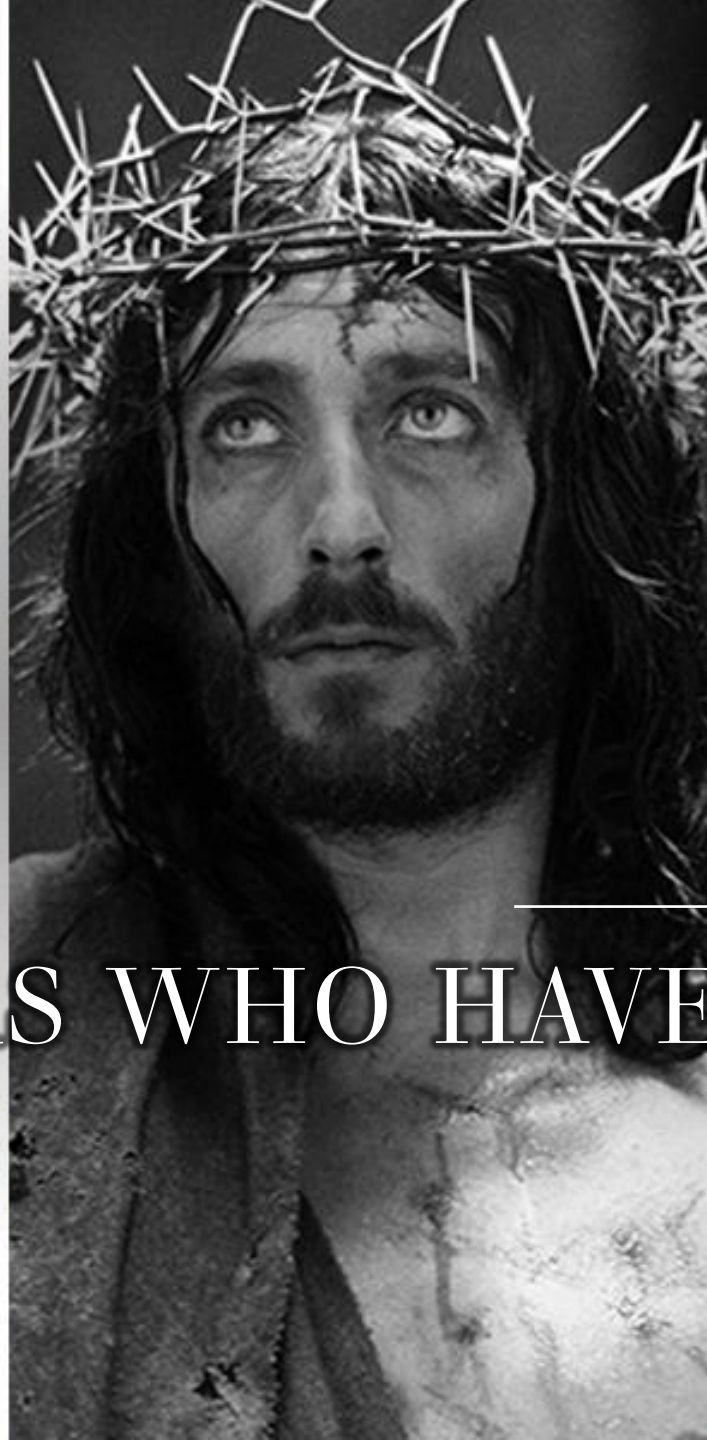


JESUS

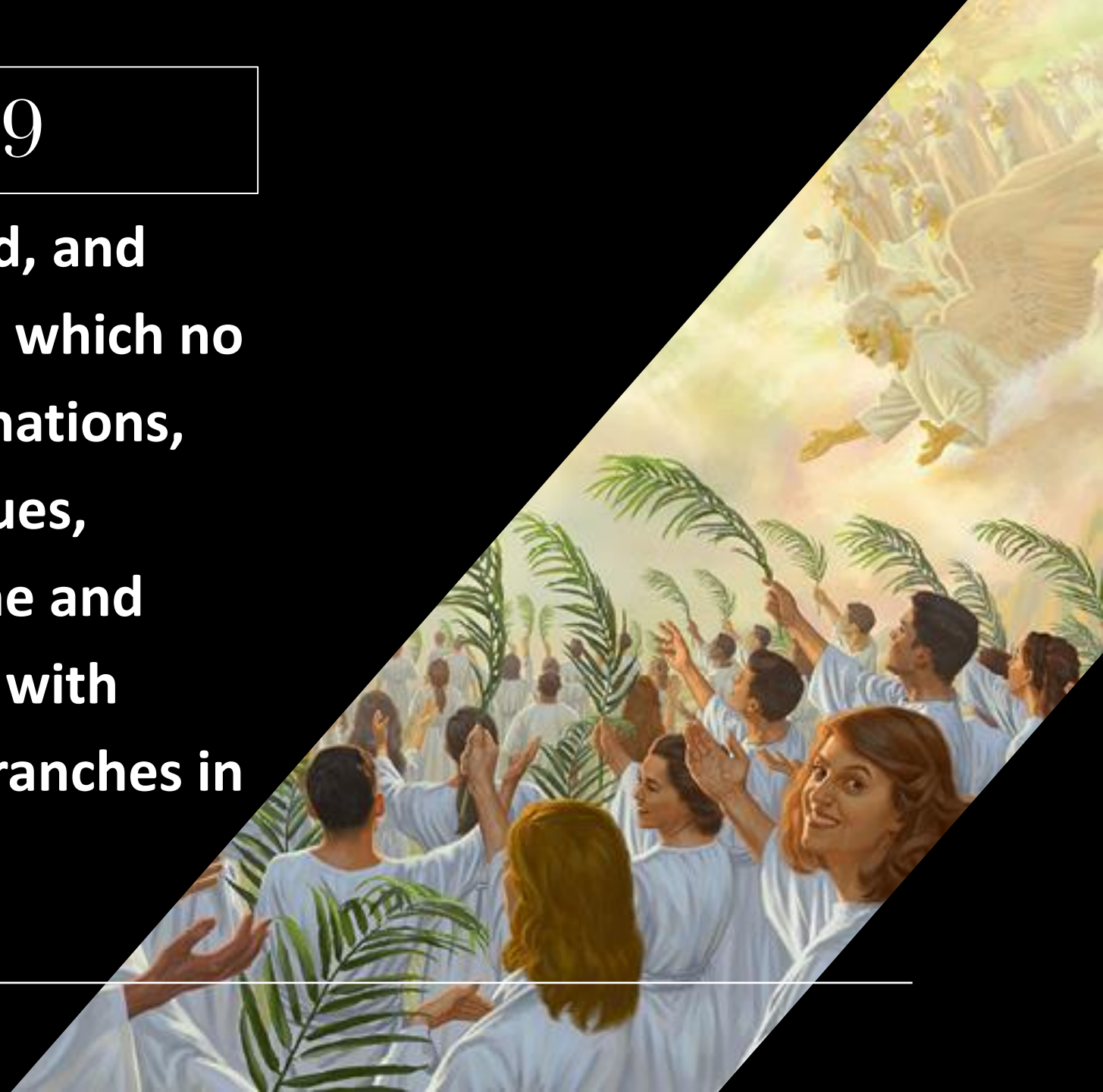

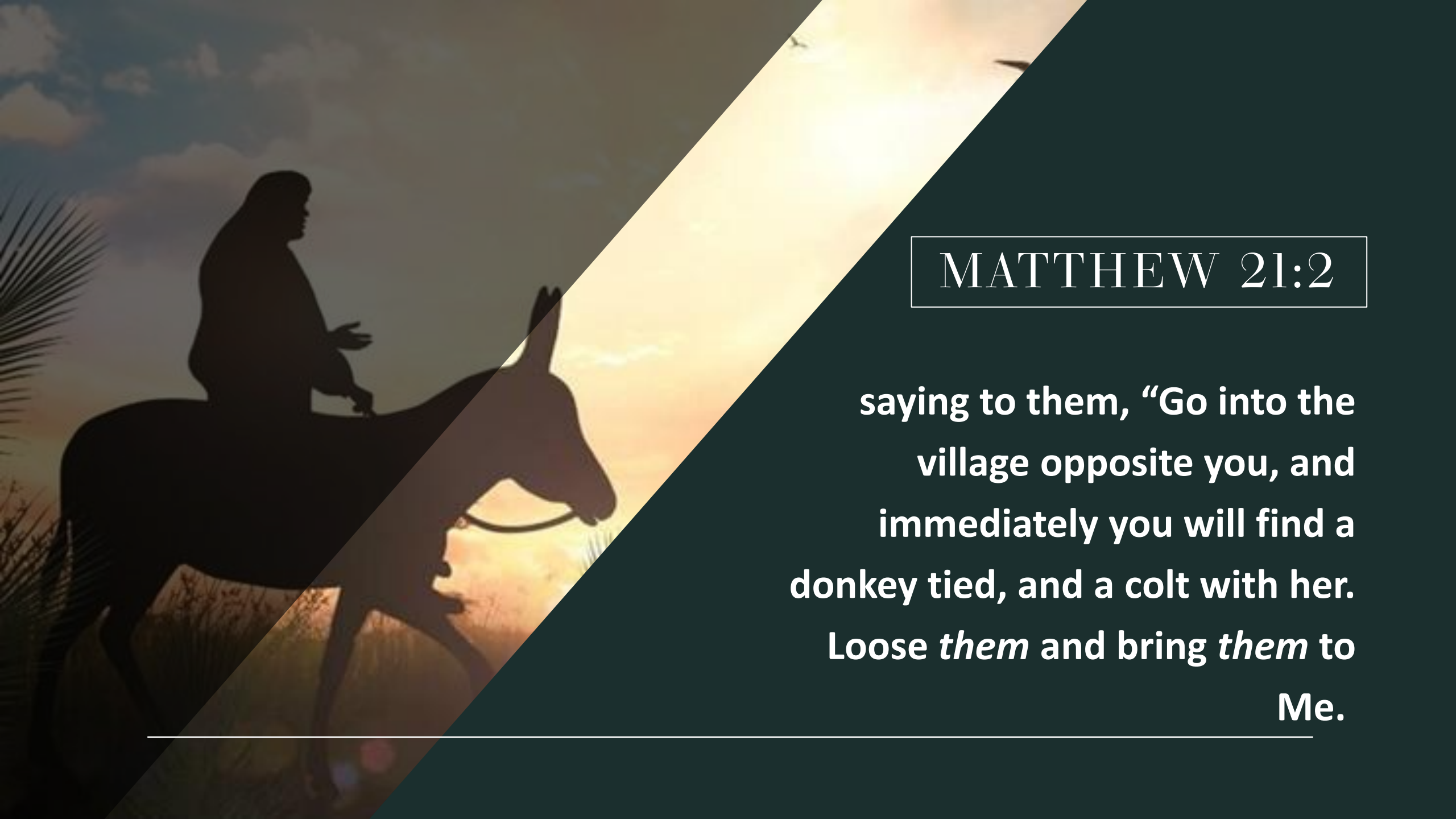

and crying out with a loud voice, saying, “Salvation *belongs* to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”



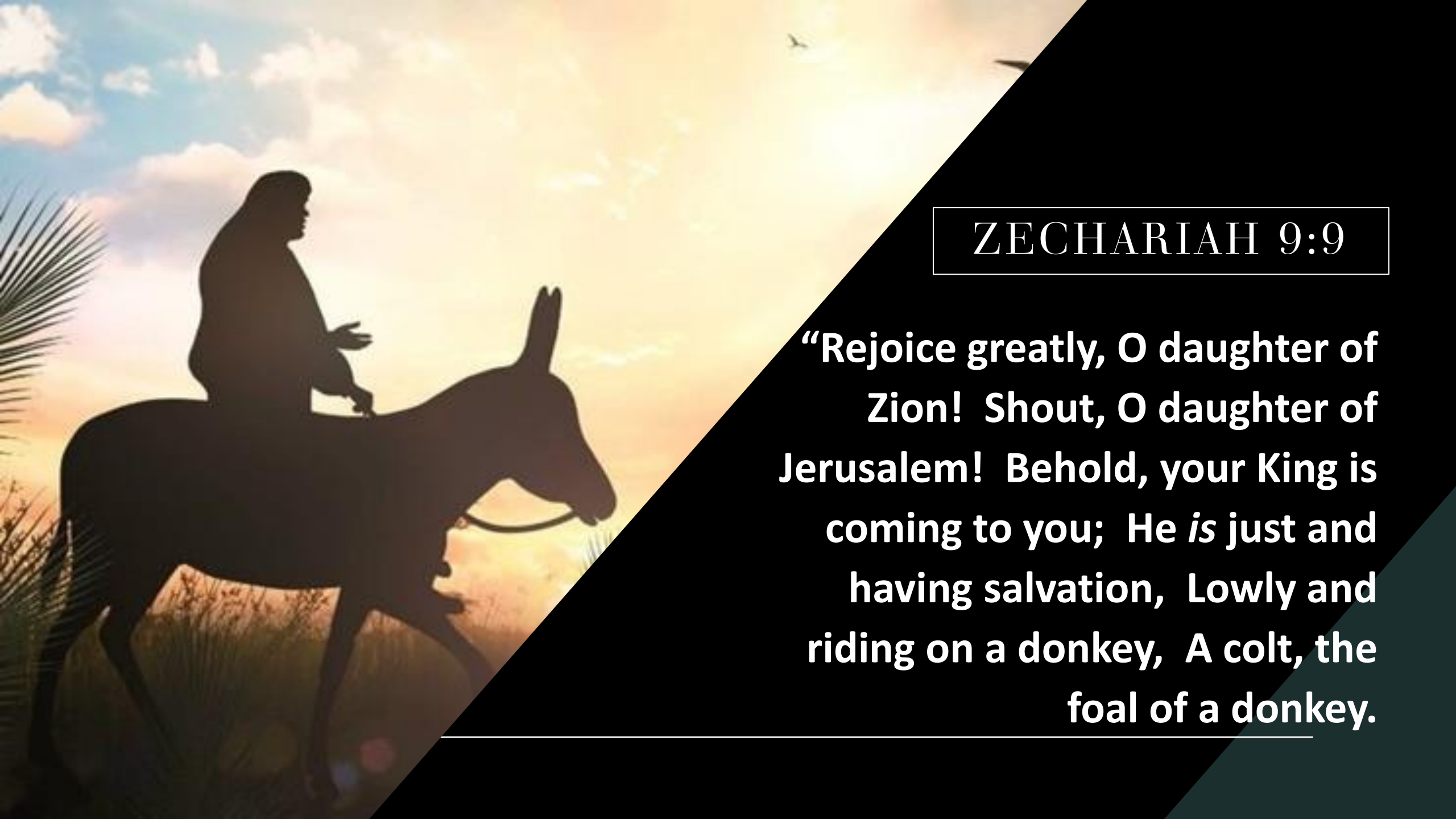


THE KING ON A DONKEY



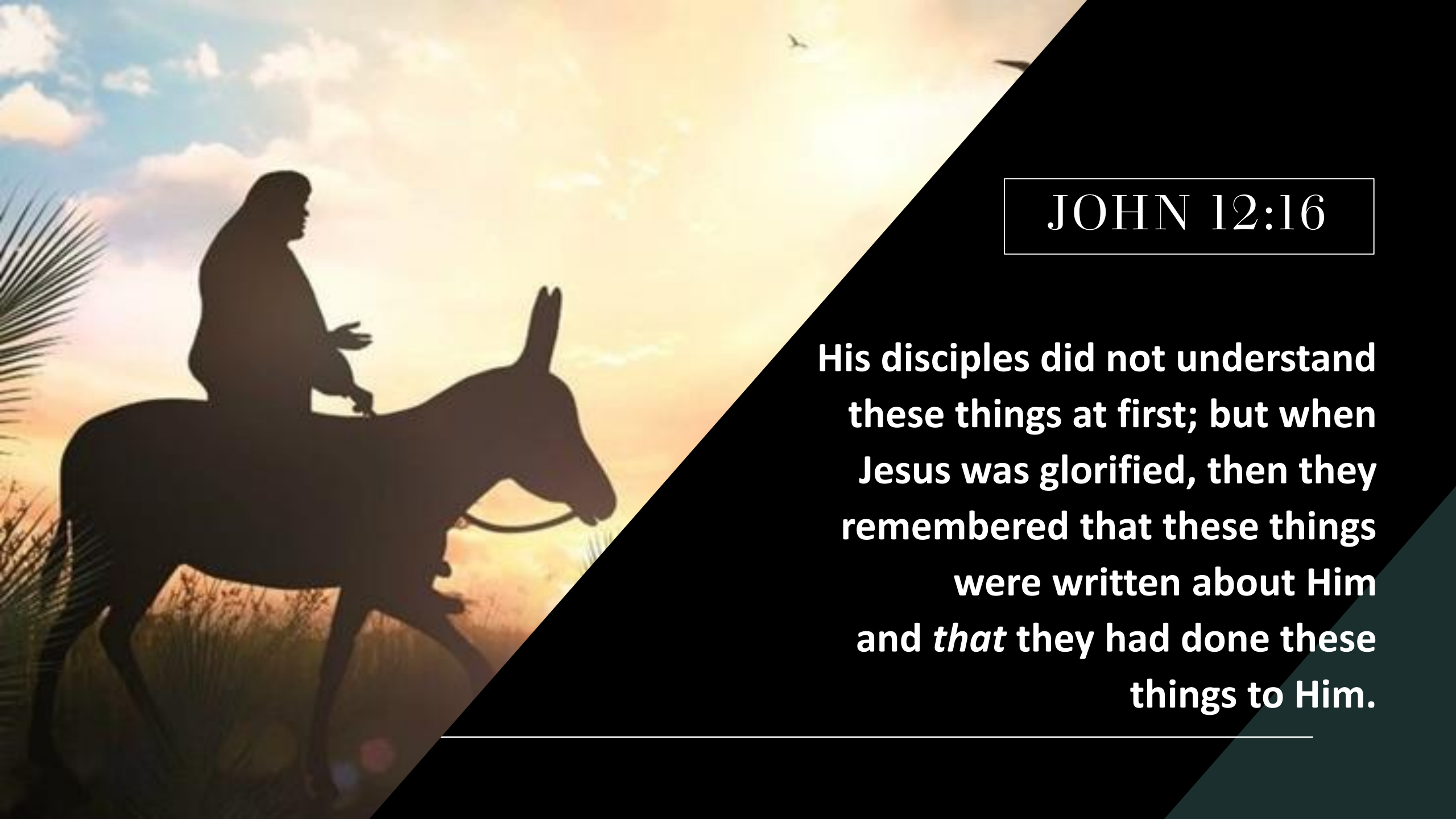
MATTHEW 21:2
