Times of Trouble at the End**

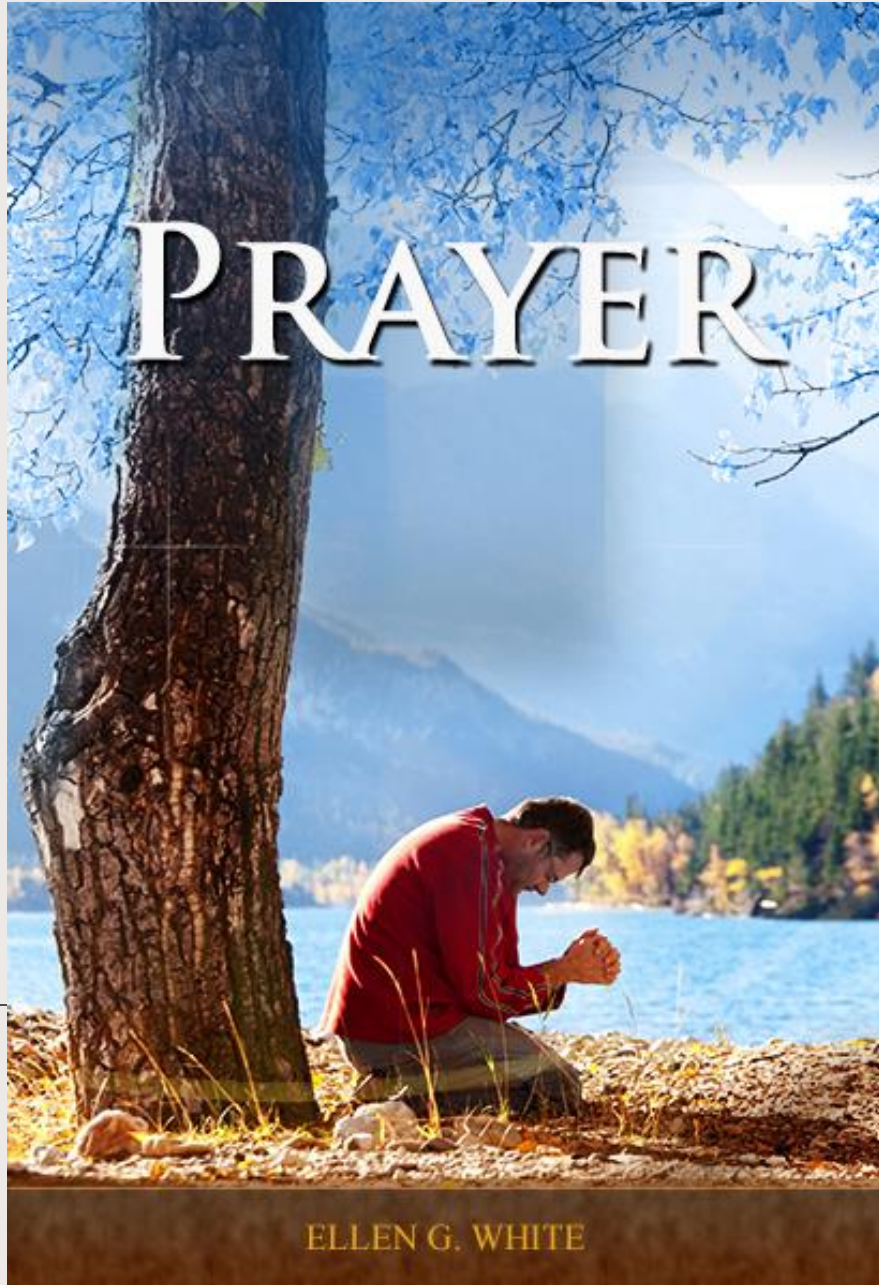
DANIEL 6:10

Our own future well-being, and also the salvation of other souls, depend upon the course which we now pursue.

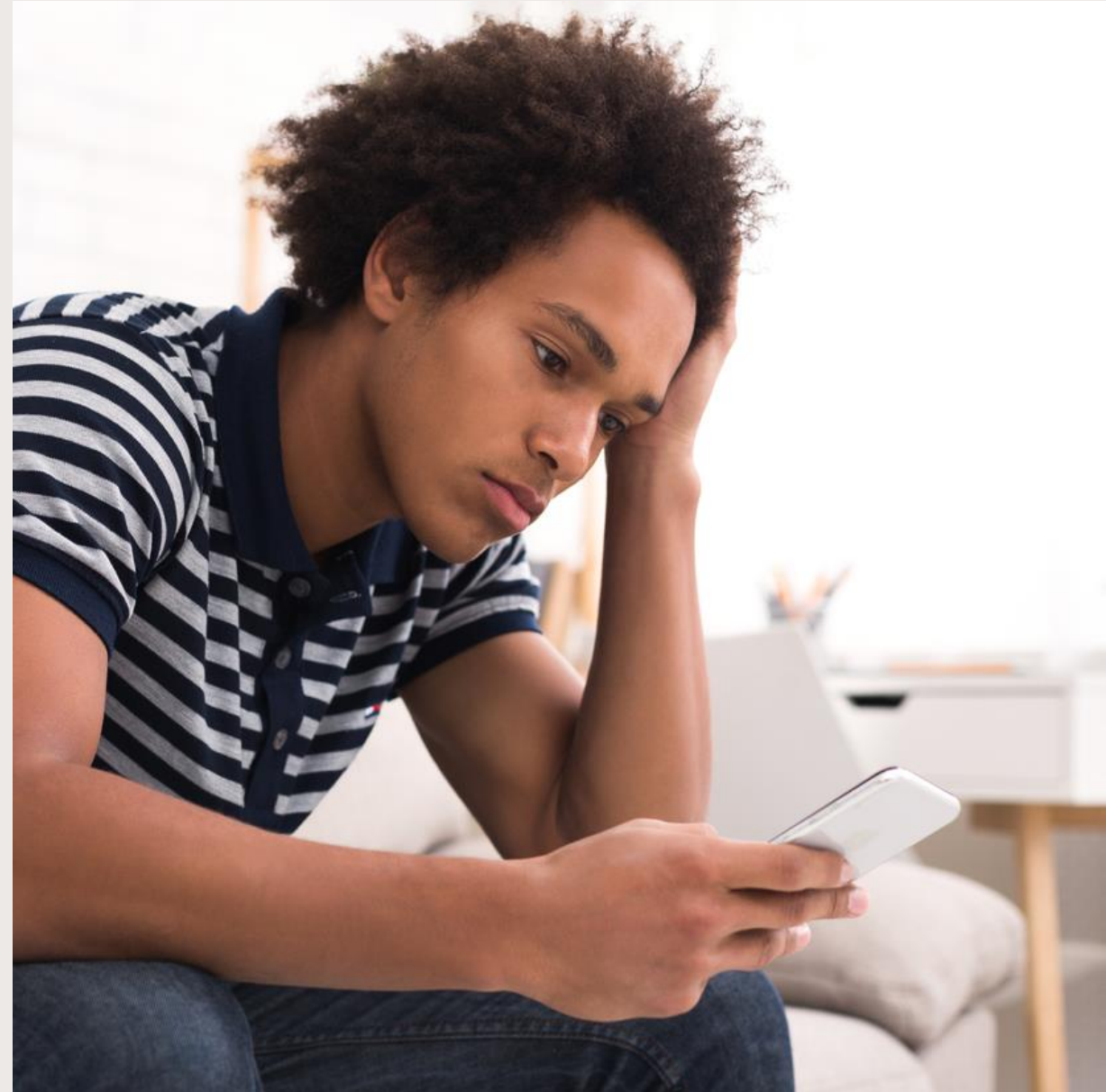
